To date, MAST has overseen \$149 million worth of construction management projects and \$427 million in construction consulting assignments, most of which has been completed. tative. Owner's representative projects include the Newark Housing Authority, Downtown Core District Redevelopment Project, the Devil's Arena and the Harrison Waterfront Redevelopment project including the MetroStars Stadium just to name a few.

Projects currently nearing completion include a \$40 million dormitory and kitchen addition at the Hudson County Correctional Center in Kearny, New Jersey and a \$19 million adaptive project reuse for a new East Orange Police Facility in East Orange, New Jersey.
